Following consultation between the designers and ege, the new carpeting was installed. The final result is a modern yet timeless and elegant style, which enhances the inviting atmosphere of the hotel's guest corridors. In addition to the carpets for the guest corridors, area rugs for the lobby were designed, contributing to the unique look and atmosphere of the overall hotel interior design.
